Svalbard, a remote Arctic wilderness where the profound silence is both vast and enveloping.

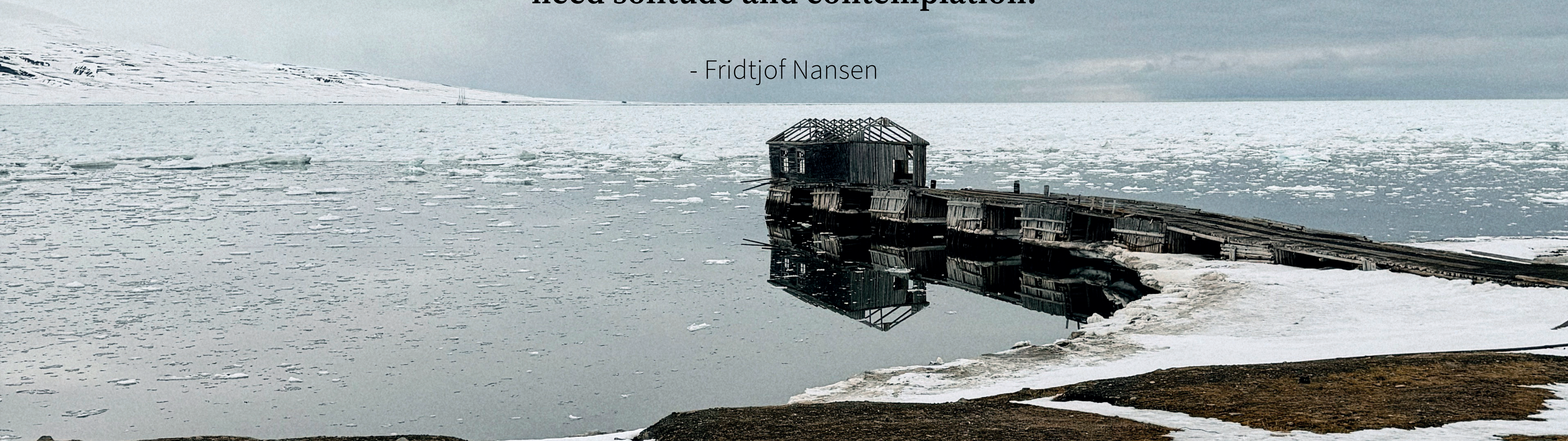

YOUR ITINERARY

Day 1

Arrive at Ålesund Airport Vigra and transfer to Storfjord, a serene slow life getaway in the fjords. Enjoy a welcome dinner with the host at Storfjord, setting the tone for an exclusive adventure.

Day 2

Start the day with a hearty breakfast before boarding the Fjord Lilly for a scenic journey down the Hjørundfjord to Union Øye. At Union Øye, attend a briefing on the location's historical significance, which has hosted many legendary adventurers. Return to Storfjord in the evening for an overnight stay.

Day 3

After breakfast, transfer from Storfjord to Ålesund Airport Vigra and board a private jet to Longyearbyen in Svalbard. Upon arrival, transfer directly to the dog yard for an afternoon run with the dogs. Experience the unique bond with these animals before heading to Basecamp Hotel for a briefing over dinner.

Day 4

Begin the day with a transfer to Basecamp HQ. Board Skidoos and embark on a five-hour journey through glaciers and peaks to Isfjord Radio. Enjoy lunch en route and arrive at the radio station in the afternoon with the setting sun on the western horizon. Spend the night at Isfjord Radio Adventure Hotel.

Day 5

Dedicate the day to exploring the glaciers around Isfjord Radio on Skidoos. Witness dramatic icefalls abandoned whaling and mining stations, and possibly see Svalbard reindeer and polar bears.

Day 6

Spend the day exploring the Nordenskiöld coast south of Isfjord Radio. Encounter the wildlife, protected whale carcasses, and possibly see polar bears. Return to Isfjord Radio for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 7

Travel back to Longyearbyen on Skidoos. Enjoy a fine dining experience at Huset in the evening, celebrating your remarkable journey through Svalbard.

Day 8

Spend the morning exploring Longyearbyen and shopping for mementos. Transfer to the airport for a private jet and return to Ålesund. Enjoy a celebration dinner at Sjøbua and stay in the suites at Brosundet.

Day 9

Transfer to Ålesund Airport Vigra for your onward journey.
