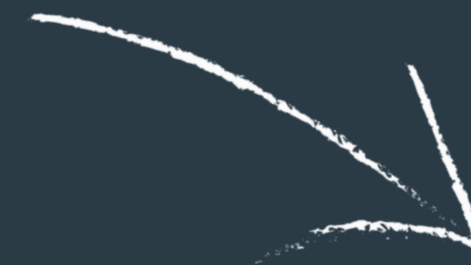
You will take the wheel, lead by pre-programmed routes that journey you

THE FJORDS

The fjords were carved by kilometre-thick glaciers out of the ancient rock, creating narrow ocean inlets flanked by sheer cliffs and awe-inspiring peaks. In days gone by, the fjords were inhabited by Viking seafarers, hardy explorers who were the first European visitors to so much of the New World.

Your adventure will be the chance for you to plot your own voyage of discovery along the flat roads at the edge of the fjords and up the winding routes through the mountains, surrounded by crystal clear lakes and deep forests that inspired Norway's folk tales of trolls and talking beasts.

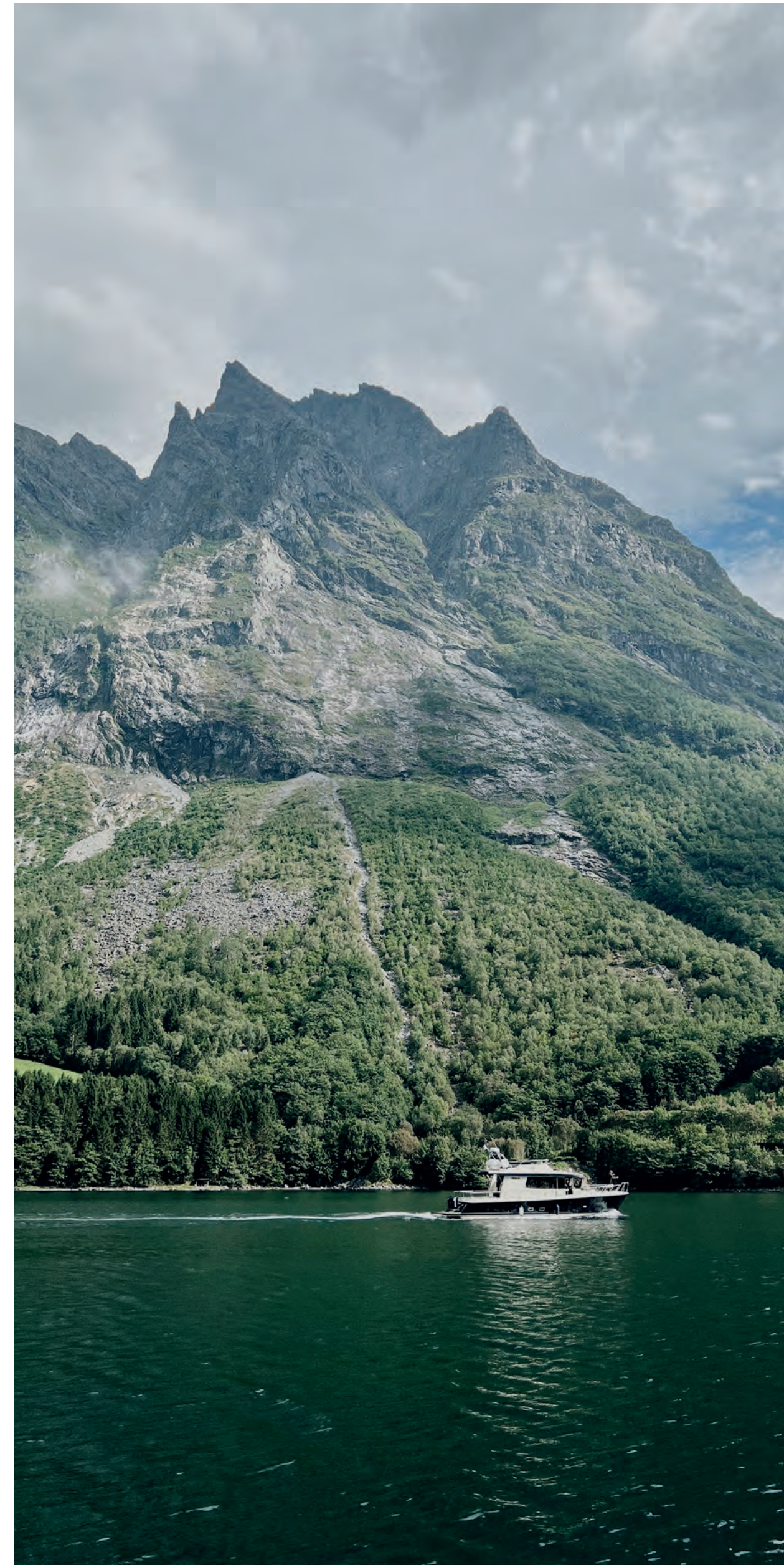
Let us take care of all the details so you can enjoy every moment of your days on the open road.

YOUR ITINERARY

Day 1

The approach to Ålesund gives you a little glimpse of what lies ahead: from the window of your aircraft, you'll see the crystal clear fjords and jagged peaks of the Sunnmøre Alps, the site of your coming adventure! On arrival, a driver will welcome you and transfer you directly to Storfjord Hotel, where we will arrange a welcome cocktail for you at the Lavvu, a traditional tent erected deep in the pine forests surrounding the hotel. Here you will have the chance to meet other guests and receive an explanation of some of the highlights of the trip ahead.

Day 2

Drive North toward the Atlantic Ocean Road. Your car will be packed with a Storfjord Picnic basket complete with local produce, cheeses, meats, berries and champagne. This dramatic overpass is a marvel of engineering as your car seems to fly over the Atlantic as you wind from island to island. On the return journey your view will be of the Sunnmøre peaks littering the horizon. This will be your playground for the next few days as you adventure goes deeper into the fjords.

Day 3

Take to the skies for a bird´s-eye view of the fjords en route to the Troll Wall. Moving deeper into the mountains the Trollstigen will appear showing the winding road to the summit. Ascend through 18 switchback corners to one of the most magnificent vantage points in all of Norway. Descend the Valdalen valley which will lead you back to the fjord. A ferry to Stranda will give you a glimpse of things to come as the fjords get narrower and deeper.

The destination: Union Øye. An historic royal oasis at the end of the valley.

Day 4

After a royal night rest and local breakfast, the quiet roads wind toward the west as the fjords seem to be left behind you. Before long you will trace the coastline towards Stryn, the perfect opportunity for lunch and a journey up the Loen Skylift for incredible views out to the North Atlantic. As you head further inland the fjord hamlet of Geiranger will edge nearer. Board the ferry, sit back and enjoy the slow steam through the grandest fjord of them all with waterfalls cascading off of the mountain tops. Disembark at Hellesylt and drive on through the Norangsdaalen valley, the finest in Northern Europe with your destination being Union Øye.

Day 5

A visit to the Sunnmøre region would not be complete without celebrating the incredible seafood that has been the backbone of the region for generations. Sjøbua sits proudly in the beautiful port city of Ålesund, a reimaged classic, this restaurant is a true triumph of the ocean and a fitting tribute to generations of fisherman from Sunnmøre. The return journey is none other than aboard the Fjord Lilly, a Targa 44 that offers the most intimate experience carving through the fjord on the way to Storfjord in Glomset.

Day 6

The last day is for reflection and to take it easy at Storfjord Hotel. Guides will be ready should you wish to explore the Glomset bay on kayak or even settle into the spa with a well-earned massage and sauna. Of course, you could drive through to Alesund to visit the famous Jugendstil town nestled on the ocean. A driver will be ready to take you to Vigra Airport and as your flight climbs away, we hope the view of the mountains and fjords will be a lasting reminder of your driving adventure with 62°NORD.
