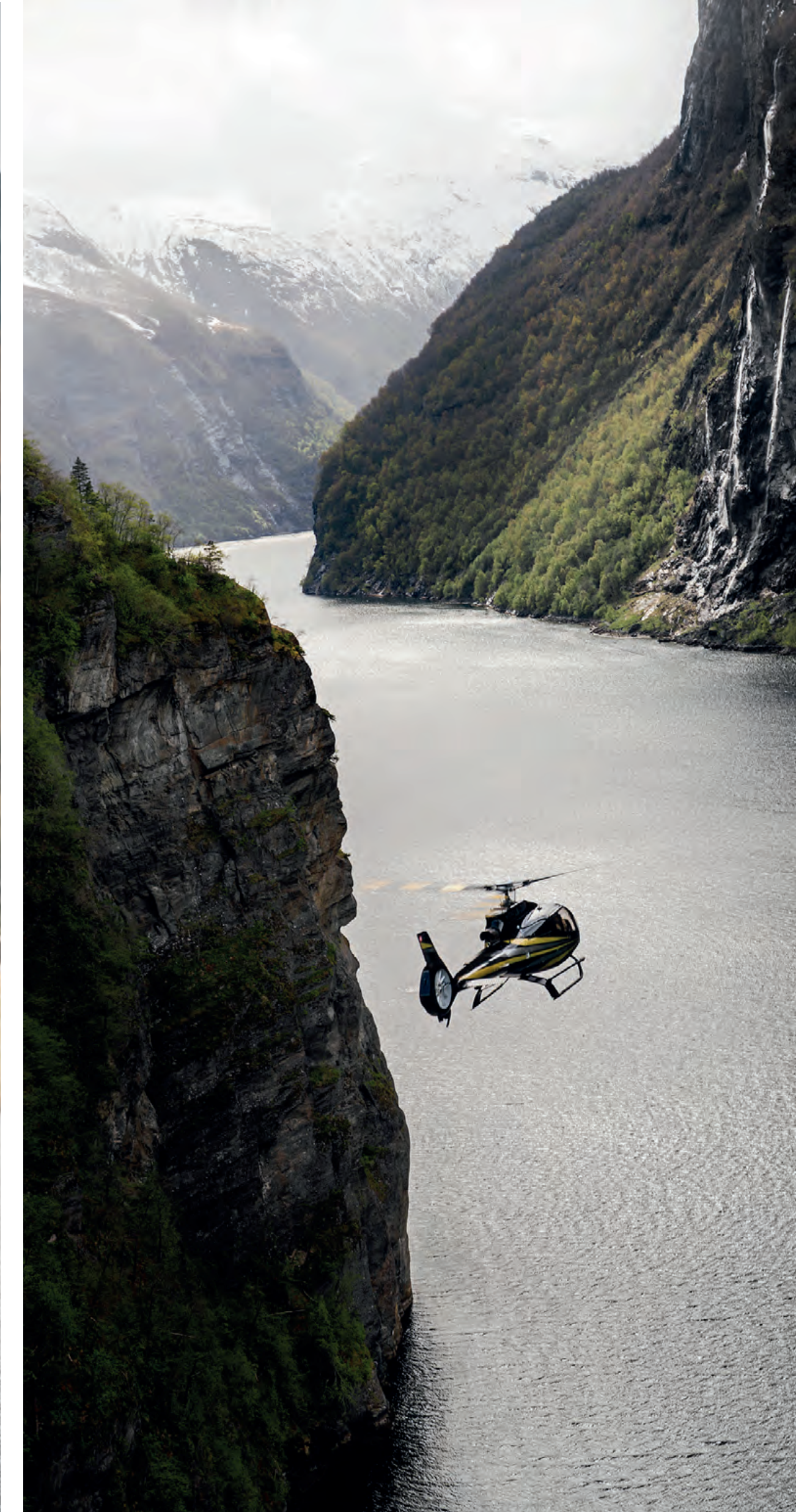
A ONE-OF-KIND ADVENTURE

THE QUEEN ROUTE

TROLLSTIGEN

The Trollstigen, the Troll Wall, is the tallest vertical rock face in Europe, famed among iconic climbers and extreme athletes, and the fitting setting for the Queen Stage of your trip.

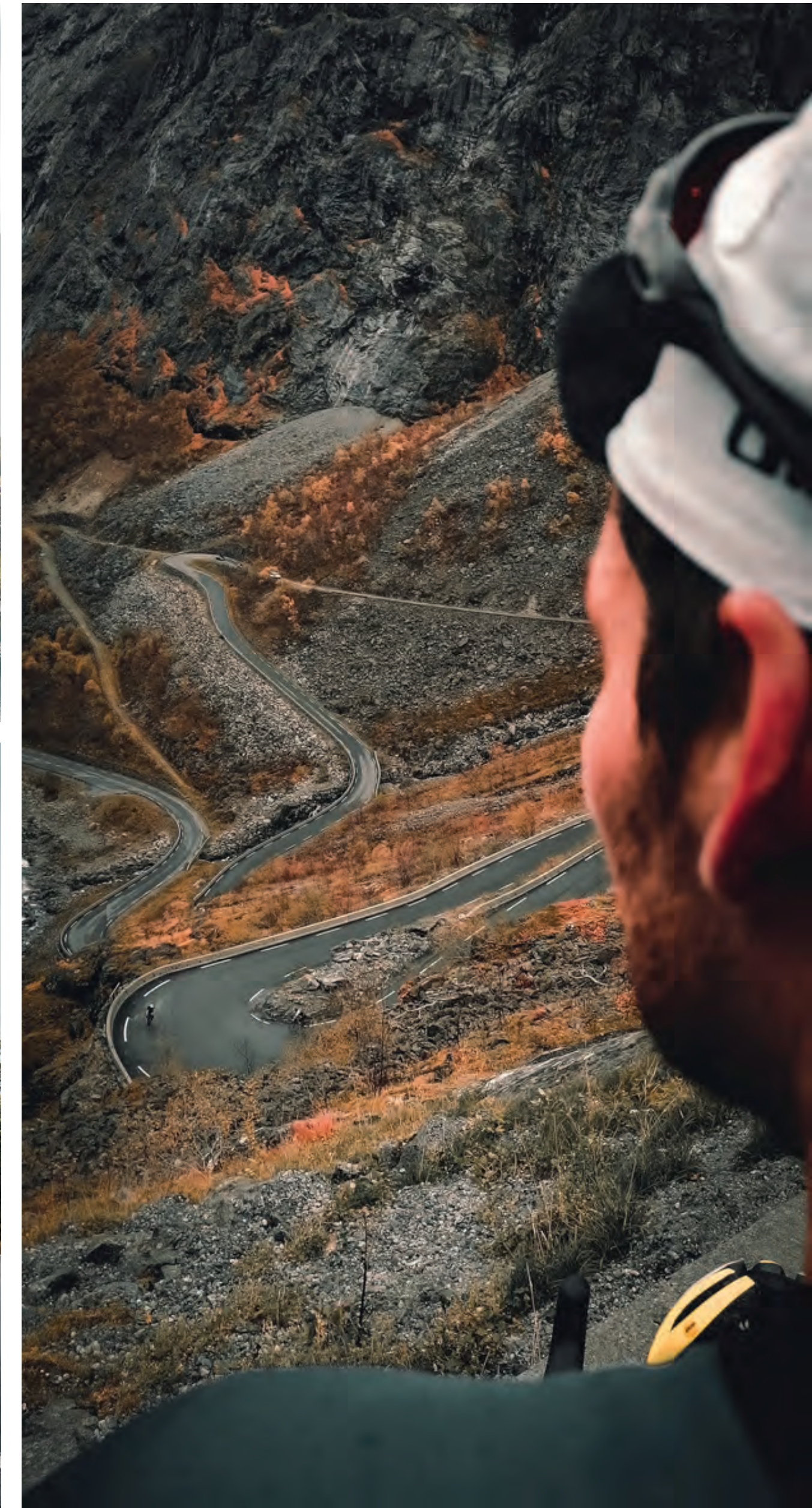
The Trollstigen climb is as dramatic as it is challenging, comprising 18 switchbacks that weave their way back and forth in front of a thundering waterfall. At the top, a lookout point at 800m offers you a chance to relive the climb and to take sensational photos of your achievement.

After a gentler section brings you to the peak, a wonderful reward awaits you – a 40km descent through the Valdalen valley. Flanked by cliffs on either side and enveloped in the calm of the forests, you'll barely touch the pedals as you make your way back down to the still waters of the fjord.

6DAYS – 400KM – 2500M

ITINERARY

Day 1

The approach to Alesund gives a small glimpse to the adventure ahead. From the window of your aircraft, you'll witness an intricate web of peaks thousands of feet high intersected by crystal clear fjords. Drivers will welcome you and bring you directly to Storfjord Hotel, where we will arrange a welcome cocktail for you at the Lavvu, a traditional tent erected deep in the pine forest surrounding the hotel. Here you will have the chance to meet your guide, who will give you an overview of the riding and explain some of the highlights of the trip ahead.

Day 2

After a gentle 5km spin you will board a ferry that will sail across the fjord to start the day's stage. After disembarking at Sykkylven, you will wind your way slowly up into the maze of peaks, relishing the clear air and Norwegian light. A lunch stop and cider-tasting will prepare you for the up for the next part of the adventure, exploring the Geiranger Fjord in fast RIB speedboats. When you reach Hellesylt, you'll be reunited with your bike, ready for the final section up and through the Norangsdal valley. After checking into Union Øye for a luxurious bath, you'll down to the Øye boathouse for a fireside barbecue by the fjord.

Day 3

The crisp fresh air will clear away any cobwebs on the first part of the day's stage to the ferry at Leknes. After a short crossing, you'll roll off at Saebø, where you will work your way around a loop to the west and south, first working your way up a valley and then over a series of rolling hills, the perfect spot for challenging yourself and your companions! You'll rejoin Hjørundfjord at Viddal, where a boat will be ready to pick you up and deliver you to Union Øye to freshen up, enjoy a lazy lunch and spend an afternoon relaxing in this spectacular valley.

Day 4

This day brings you a dramatic stage of two halves. The first takes you up out of the Hjørundfjord and round to the north, where a short climb will get keen riders out of the saddle and dancing on the pedals. After regrouping, you'll descend a long valley to a set of thrilling switchbacks that lead you to the fjord-side village of Store Standal. A well-earned burger lunch follows while you enjoy incredible views of the Norwegian Alps, before the second half of the stage sees the group speeding out of the Hjørundfjord to the Festøy finish where we will call it a day and take you back to Storfjord Hotel by boat.

Day 5

The Queen Stage of your trip begins with a helicopter flight. You'll be dropped off at the start of a steady approach to the Trollstigen, Europe's tallest vertical rock face. 1100m high, you will need to overcome 18 switchback corners to conquer the climb. Working back and forth across it, you'll be followed by the support vehicle in case you need any gels – or to shed a layer or two! The view from the top will make it all worthwhile, while the 40km descent on the other side will be one of the highlights of the whole trip. Our boats will be waiting for you at Valldal, ready to transfer you back to Storfjord Hotel where we will have celebratory drinks at the boathouse at the edge of the fjord.

Day 6

The last wind-down stage is a quick 40km loop to work the hills and fjords out of your legs and to give you a last chance to ride with your group – although you always have the choice of a treatment at our spa or just relaxing in the idyllic surroundings beside the fjord. Shuttles will take you to Vigra airport and as your flight climbs away, we hope the view of the mountains and fjords will be a lasting reminder of your two-wheeled adventure with 62 NORD!
